Instructions

This application is designed to give us a sense of your academic achievements, your background and your interests in and out of school. The essay portions of the application will give you a chance to let us know how you see the world and to demonstrate your skill as a writer. The open-ended questions do not have one “right answer,” each individual will answer them differently. We encourage you to let us know what you think, not what you think we want to hear. Some of the questions are meant to be fun so enjoy yourself!

The creative supplement portion of the application is optional. If you have an example of creative work that you would like to share with us, please hand in a representation of it with your application. Please do not submit original work. Creative supplements include such things as: an audio or videotape of music, dancing, or a theatrical performance; art portfolios; examples of craftsmanship such as a carpentry or boat building project; computer programs, web site design; creative writing, or poetry.

Two of the references should be filled out by your current Math teacher and your current English or History teacher. Additional references from teachers outside these subject areas are welcome. The personal reference should be completed by an adult who knows you well but is not a relative.

Transcripts or narrative reports from the past three years should be returned with your application materials. If you have been home schooled, evaluations written by your teachers may be substituted. We ask that any formal test results that are pertinent to your academic performance also be submitted.
